Wool Washing Checklist



1. Does it actually need a wash?

Wool naturally repels dirt, dust and liquids so typically doesn't need a wash after every wear.

Garments can be refreshed with the LITTLE BEAU SHEEP Wool & Cashmere Spray.



2. Read the label

Take a little time to study the care instructions and understand what all the symbols mean.



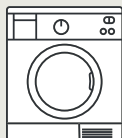
3. Wash or steam?

Even a gentle wash can be too much for some fabrics, so you might want to consider investing in a hand-held garment steamer to take care of any germs or odours.



4. Kill those pills:

You might call them bobbles or bits – these little bumps of wool on the surface of your jumper are a result of friction. Invest in a fabric shaver (being careful to only go in one direction) and you'll look good as new.



5. Let's wash and roll

6. Any old iron?

"Most certainly not!" When it comes to ironing, look for the wool setting on your iron's dial. If it doesn't have one, go for the lowest setting.



7. Store in a drawer... avoid the hangers

To prevent your woollies stretching and becoming misshapen, it's best to avoid hangers. Instead, fold and then store your jumper in a drawer or on a shelf.
